

Bible Timeline: Noah's Flood

Bible Timeline: Noah's Flood

Passage	Comment
Gen 7:1-9	Noah enters the ark and waits for seven days.
Gen 7:10-12, 21- 23	All the fountains of the great deep burst forth, and the windows of the heavens were opened, raining for 40 days and nights, destroying all life on the earth. (Month 2, Day 17)
Gen 7:17, 24; 8:3	Waters prevailed and abated. Ark floats for a total of 150 days. (5 months, from Month 2 till Month 7) *
Gen 8:3-4	Ark comes to rest on Ararat. This is the same calendar day as Jesus' resurrection. (Month 7, Day 17)
Gen 8:5	Mountain tops seen. (Month 10, Day 1)
Gen 8:6-7	After forty days, Noah sends out a raven.
Gen 8:8-9	(After 7 day wait?), Noah sends first dove; no land found; brought back in.
Gen 8:10-11	After 7 day wait, Noah sends second dove. Dove returns that evening with an olive branch.
Gen 8:12	After 7 day wait, Noah sends third dove. Dove doesn't return.
Gen 8:13	Waters dried. (Month 1, Day 1)
Gen 8:14-17	Earth dried; Noah, family and animals exit ark. (Month 2, Day 27)

^{*} For ancient calendars, a year consisted of 12 months of 30 days. Every 2-3 years, an intercalary month was added to keep the seasons on track.
